In the event that the number of registrants exceeds capacity, those of foreign nationality will be admitted first, followed by domestic participants who will then be selected via lottery.

12. Rules of Play Gameplay will be subject to the rules of the Japan Ground Golf Association.
13. Details of Play ★ Day 1: September 27th (Fri.)
Participants will play on 3 of the 4 courses -- In, Out, Cape, and Square (each of which contain 8 holes) -- for a total of 24 holes.
★ Day 2: September 28th (Sat.)
Participants will play 8 holes on the course that they did not use on Day 1 -- In, Out, Cape, or Square.
- Each individual will be ranked based on their total number of strokes from all 4 rounds.

17. Other Information 1. Players must use clubs and balls that have been certified by the Japan Ground Golf Association. The event organizer is not responsible for any accidents caused by the use of non-certified equipment. The individual who used such equipment will be responsible.
**We will provide free equipment rentals to those who need it.*
2. Players are to provide their own markers, but may also use those which will be given as participation prizes.
3. The event organizer will take out a sports insurance policy.
4. In the event of an accident during play, only first-aid measures will be provided. Any subsequent responsibility will be confined to what is covered by insurance.
5. The event organizer will provide Japanese box lunches.
6. The event program is subject to change in the event of inclement weather.
7. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.
8. The event organizer will decide on any other matters not specified herein that are necessary for the operation of the tournament.
9. A social event for tournament participants will be held on Thursday, September 26th, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. (Venue: Suimeiso)
10. A subsidy of ¥5,000 JPY per night, per person will be provided to those who book their accommodations at Hawaii Onsen or Togo Onsen through our executive committee (see attachment). **No. 10 is only for foreigners*
